**USEFUL LINKS:** 

Case – Lab confirmed case of Covid-19

**Probable** – Close contacts of lab confirmed cases with symptoms consistent with Covid-19

**Recovered** – Resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications and improvements in respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath) and 7 days have passed since symptoms first appeared. Recovered counts include probable case recoveries.
