CFAO Joanne Kolb gave an update on 2017 sales and expenses compared to budget. Year-to-date ystem sales for February 2017 are down 1.6% compared to February 2016. February year-to-date resulted in a positive operating margin of approximately \$316,579, which is under budget by \$263,493.
